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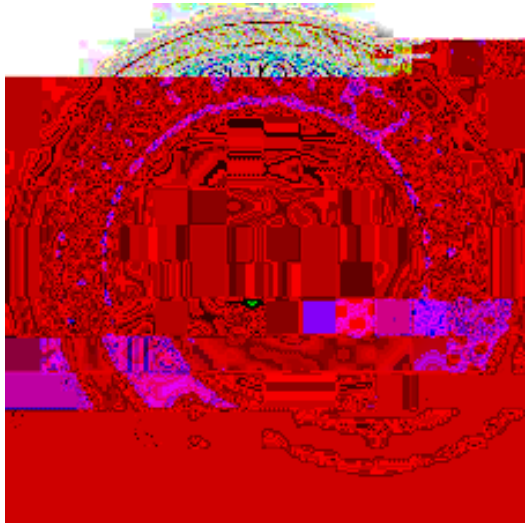
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History:

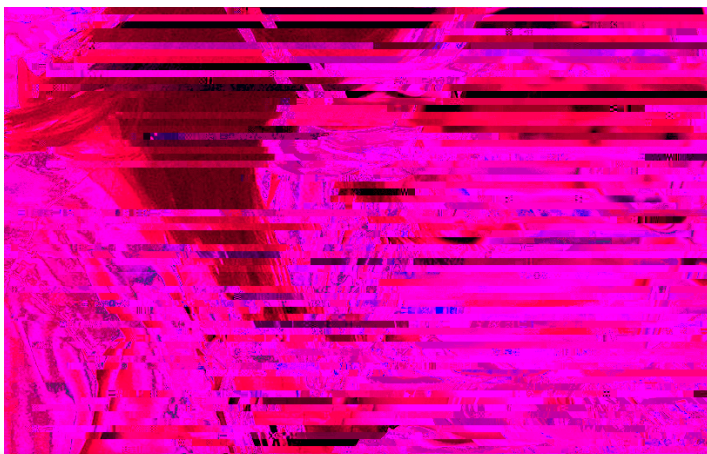
Resident Education and Curriculum

- o Tumor Board
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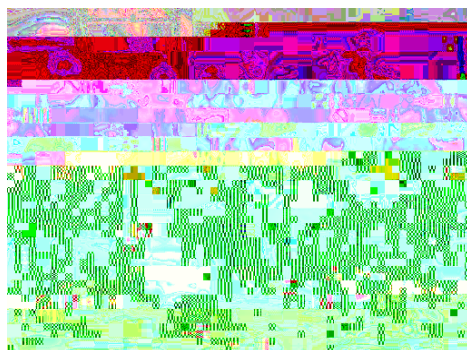
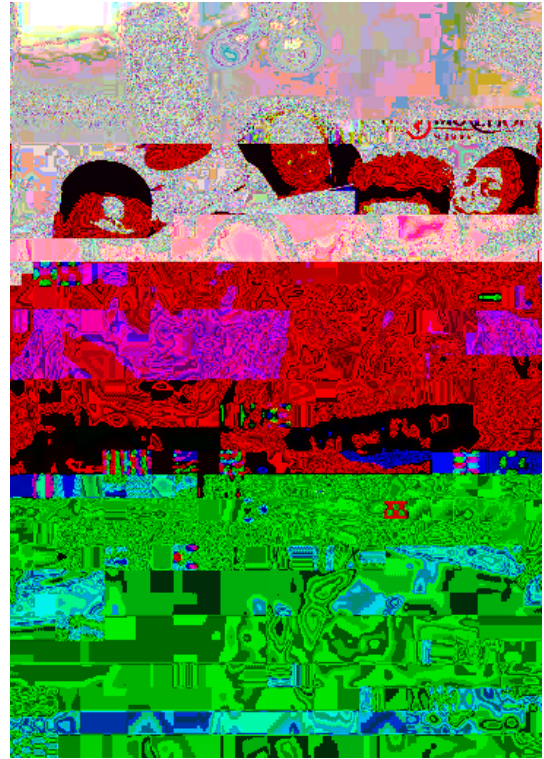
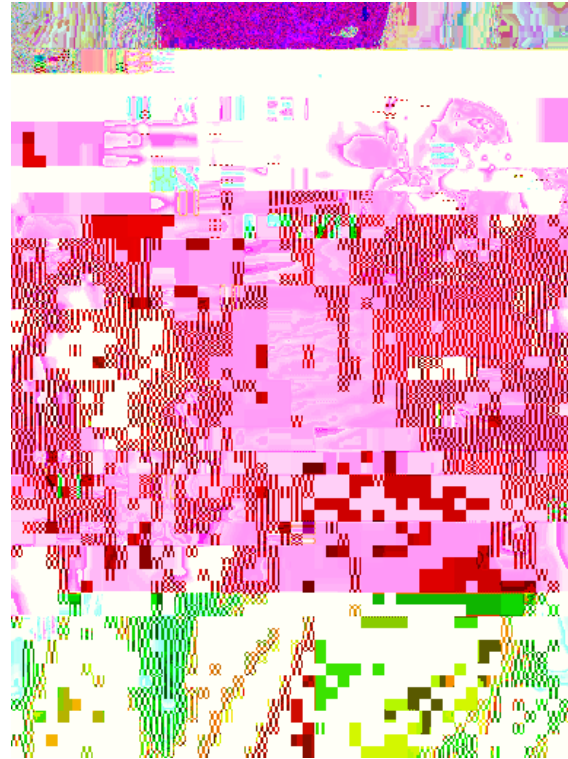
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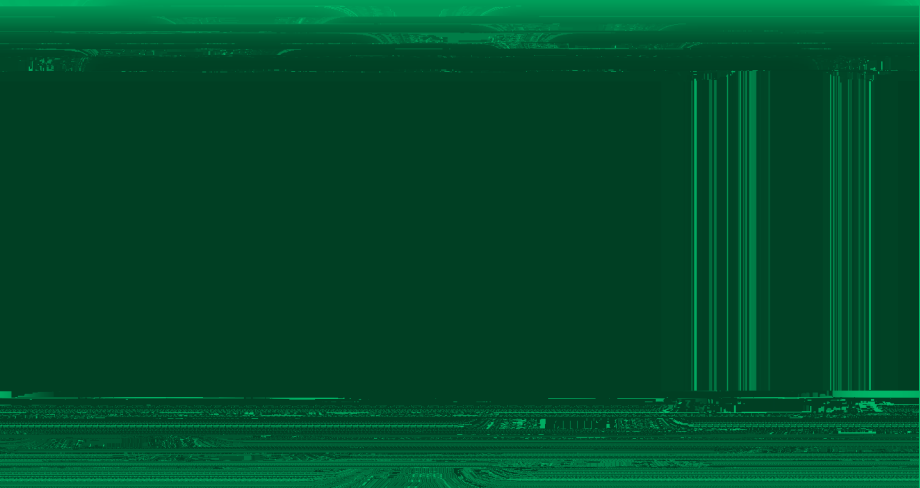
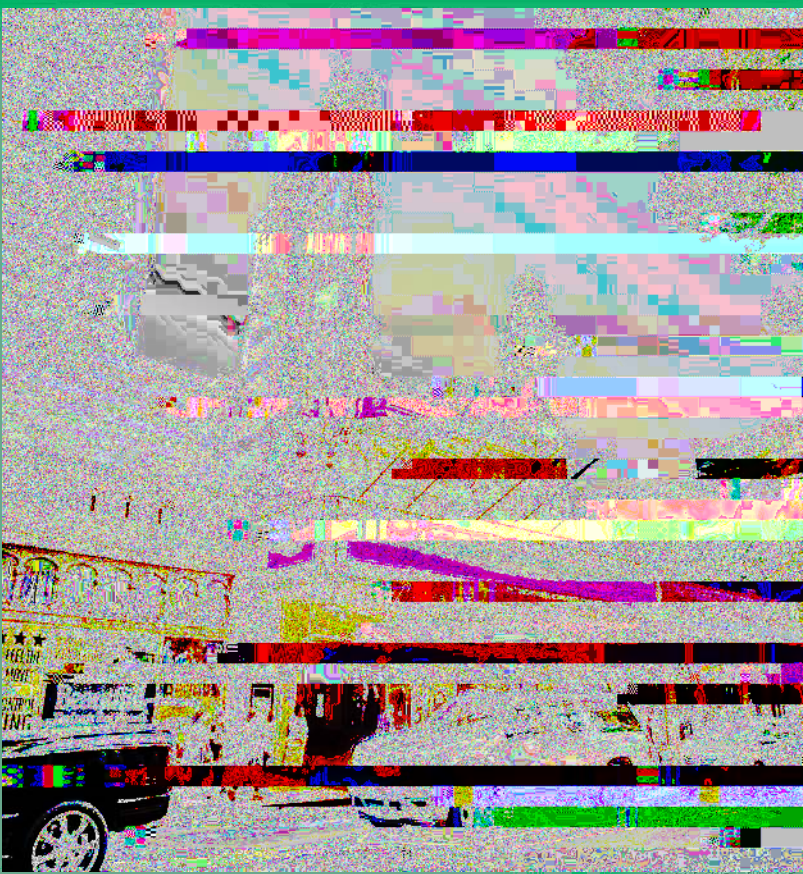
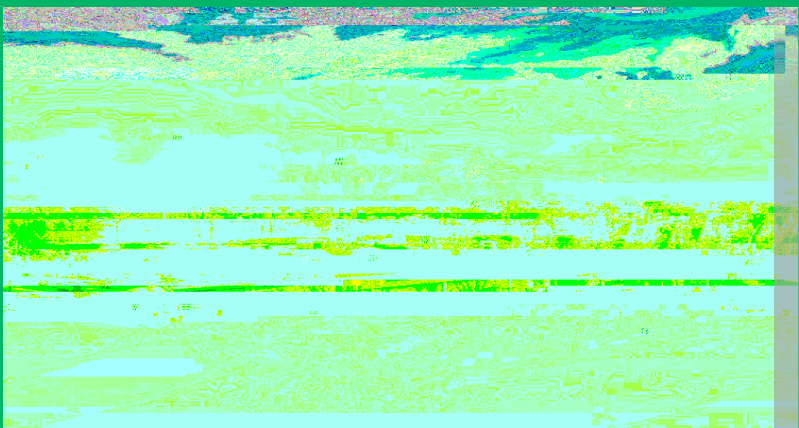
