MSM PRC staff and CCB members collected information from state, county, city and local governments, community-serving organizations, and partner agencies to learn more about the residents of the City of Atlanta and Fulton County. Additionally, 607 residents of NPU's T, V, X, Y, and Z completed a survey to provide feedback on the major health issues in the community, health-related policy, system or environmental issues, health resource availability, and the best ways to share health information.

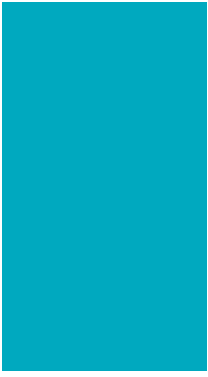


The MSM PRC conducted a community health needs & assets assessment to:

Engage the Community Coalition on Board and other community stakeholders in identifying the health needs of the community for potential research and program areas.

Collect qualitative and quantitative data from community stakeholders and secondary data sources to identify the health priority needs of the communities served.

Use recommendations from the community related to planning and implementing research, disease prevention, health promotion, policy, and evaluation initiatives to develop a community-driven research and program agenda.



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
